On Friday, April 8, 2011 students at La Salle Institute will participate in our fourth annual **Race for Education**. The actual cost for a La Salle education is over \$14,000. Funds from the Race for Education help make up the difference between our actual cost and a student's tuition so we can provide a quality education at an affordable tuition. **Know that your participation in this fund raiser is critical.**

Each student/teacher will raise funds by asking sponsors to contribute a tax deductible amount based on either the number of laps completed (i.e., \$1.00 per lap, etc.) or a flat donation. Last year we had 100% participation and raised over \$70,000. For the competition students may walk or jog around a ¼ mile area as many times as they are able in an hour's time. Students and classes have an opportunity to compete for a number of prizes and awards based on their participation in the Race for Education.
