**CAMPUS MINISTRY** - We will begin our annual **Penny Wars Fundraiser** for our twin school, St. Mary's in Kenya today. St. Mary's is a Christian Brothers school in Nyeri, Kenya that we have supported for over 15 years. It is a school for orphans and the poorest of the poor that relies on our donations to keep their students housed and fed. We ask the students to collect all of the change that they can find and simply put it in their grade's container during their lunch period. Each cent they put in their container gives their grade a point. Paper bills count as negative points and these you would put in another grade's container to drive their point value down. The grade with the most points in the middle school and high school will both win a dress down day. We ask that you take whatever change you can spare and send it to school with your sons and have them donate it to this very worthy cause. This will run until Wednesday, May 23<sup>rd</sup>. **For the first time in Penny Wars history we will have a friendly competition with CBA to see which school can raise the most money. They are having their own Penny Wars competition at the same time as us and the school that raises the most will earn a dress down day for the whole school.** Every cent we collect will be given directly to St. Mary's and you can be confident that this money will save and transform the students of St. Mary's lives.
