Homecoming Dance

Dress Code: The purpose for these guidelines is to ensure that all students understand the proper dress requirements for the homecoming dance. Students not in compliance with these guidelines will not be permitted to enter the dance. This dance is considered semi-formal and as such, the dress guidelines are as follows:

Girls:

- May wear sundress, party dress, Sunday dresses, skirts, or dress pants
- Strapless and spaghetti strap dresses/tops are not allowed.
- Dresses should not be more than 5 inches above the knee (including slits)
- No backless or midriff-revealing dresses and no revealing bustlines
- Clothing must hide all undergarments and Material may not be see-through
- Jeans, denim, shorts or cargos are not allowed
- Do not bring big bags or backpacks the dance

Boys:

- Must wear dress pants, dress shirt with a collar, and tie
- Jeans, denim, shorts or cargos are not allowed
- Shirt must be tucked in and belt must be worn
- Dress or other clean, close-toed shoes only—no sandals
- Do not bring big bags or backpacks to the dance

Dance Code of Conduct: The purpose for these guidelines is to promote a safe, clean, and fun environment at our dance. The style of dancing must reflect proper behavior and respect between students. All students and their guests must refrain from inappropriate behavior and dancing on the dance floor. Examples of inappropriate dancing:

- Dancing too closely to one another
- Dance moves that are sexually provocative
- Freaking or dirty type dancing
- Front to back dancing
- As determined by the chaperones

Consequences for failing to comply with dance code of conduct:

First Offense - A warning will be given by the chaperones.

Second Offense - The student will be asked to leave the dance floor, parents will be called, and the student will have to leave the dance.
